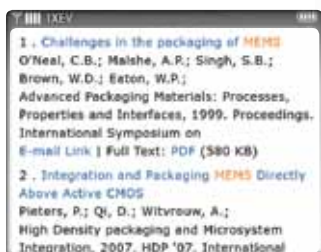
Newly refined features based on your feedback are now in IEEE Xplore Mobile

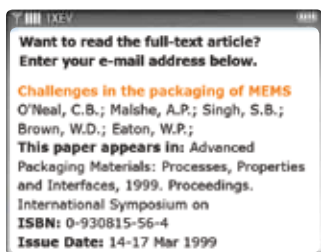
When you need it, find it fast with IEEE Xplore Mobile



◀ From the IEEE Xplore Mobile home page, type in your search term and click "Go."
New—Enable JavaScript in your device's options to view suggested searches while typing (type ahead).



◀ You'll get article abstracts with citations to read now or e-mail to yourself.
New—view all results 10 at a time.
New—to refine results you can search within results or use filters at the bottom of the screen.



◀ To view a full-text article, e-mail it to yourself. Subscribers can view articles from the main IEEE Xplore Web site. Non-subscribers can purchase articles or subscribe to IEEE Xplore.

New—If you are at a subscribing institution authenticated by IP address, you can use your WiFi-enabled device to connect to your institution's WiFi to receive full-text access documents, based on your institution's subscription.
